

Intro-Latin III-- Syllabus

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Course Description: In Latin for Children, Primer C, students will continue their study of basic Latin grammar by learning the last two noun declensions and the last verb conjugation. Students will also learn new adjectives, adverbs, and three new tenses! As in Primer B, students will learn another 240 Latin words for a total, over three years, of 720!

Primer C reviews all the grammar learned in the previous two Primers as well as introducing new grammar. The review is spread throughout the book making regular “easy” sections interspersed between “heavier” new grammar chapters.

The text is designed along a nautical theme. Chapter by chapter, students will follow the adventures of a brave sea captain and his crew whose stories will be told in Latin. Also, scattered throughout the book are pictures of famous explorers and famous Americans from colonial history. Students can log on to www.ClassicalAcademicPress.com to find out who is who.
